Also, the teacher knowing their students will be able to present the new vocabulary and the supporting language to the students at a developmentally appropriate level. Through this process the students will be able to effectively acquire the new vocabulary as well as observe how the vocabulary is used in a common grammatical form.

Activities

1. Speak the words as the activity with each picture in this book.
2. Cut out pictures from a magazine of all the winter clothing that is taught in this book. Make a collage of winter clothing. Practice saying each word. Cut out picture of children having fun in the winter. Make a collage of winter fun.
3. Have your child cut out a picture of a child. Place the clothing pictures on/or near the appropriate place it should be worn. Practice saying each word.
4. Cut out clothing words from the activity page in this book. Practice saying each word.
 - a. Place the cut out words on the correct picture that has been taught in this book.
 - b. Practice saying each word.
5. Get dressed: For Children
 - a. Get some large clothing. Big enough for each child to put on over their clothes. (hat, mittens, scarf, boots, jacket, snow pants)
 - b. Practice saying each word for the piece of clothing.
 - c. Practice role playing with the phrase “ ___ra howağukre.”
Note: When telling to put on shoes you say: “ ___ra wawoojane.”
6. “I can see a _____ .“
 - a. Get some magazine or book that has a lot of the clothing that has been taught in the book.
 - b. Have the children find a piece of clothing. Practice saying each word in Hoocak for the piece of winter clothing.
 - c. When possible use the phrase: “ ___izə hacana.” Use the winter clothing words in the book for the blank space provided.

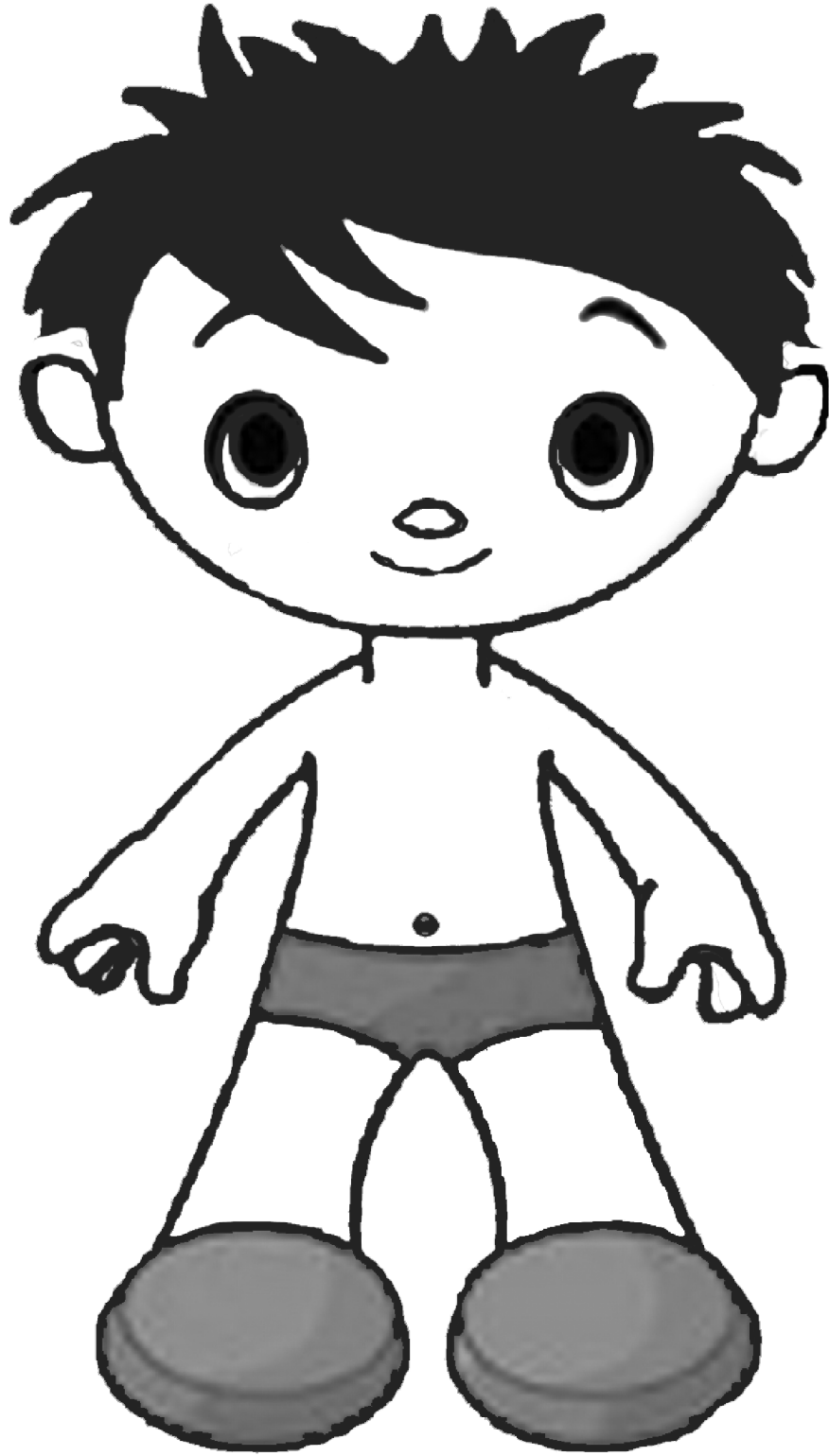
