

This series of picture books are to be used, initially, in a teacher directed activity. They are to be used as a method of learning new vocabulary. Although looking at the pictures helps the reader learn just the word, a proficient speaker, when using these books will not only be able to provide the pronunciation of the word but also create opportunities to present more supplementary language. Also, the teacher knowing their students will be able to present the new vocabulary and the supporting language to the students at a developmentally appropriate level. Through this process the students will be able to effectively acquire the new vocabulary as well as observe how the vocabulary is used in a common grammatical form.


